Día de los Muertos museum

The 4th annual *Día de los Muertos* museum popped up at Joe Michell on November 1st. Spanish 1C studies this pre hispanic tradition which UNESCO recognizes as an <u>Intangible Cultural Heritage for Humanity</u>. The theme, "Those who have gone before," honored influential artists, writers, and activists of Hispanic heritage from the United States, Puerto



Rico, Mexico, Peru, and Cuba. For the first time the art classes and the Spanish 1C classes were able to collaborate on the museum project. Mrs. Suassuna worked with the 8th grade art classes to create flowers, all kinds of skulls and an original portrait of each individual *muerto*. Spanish 1C students researched their honorees in terms of achievements and which IB profile trait they most represented. The day of the museum students guided small groups through the exhibits, explaining elements of the *ofrenda* and sharing the contributions and IB traits of each person. Students and teachers also got to dress the part with face painting and authentic dresses from Oaxaca and Veracruz, Mexico.
