(A teacher vacancy is a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of the year for an entire year or, if the position is for a one-semester course, a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of a semester for an entire semester.)  Teacher mis-assignment: A teacher who lacks credentials or training to teach English learners is assigned to teach a class with one or more English learner pupils in the class.  Teacher mis-assignment: A teacher is assigned to teach a class for which the teacher lacks subject matter competency.	
4. High School Exit Examination (For school districts who receive intensive instruction funds)  Pupils who have not passed the high school exit exam by the end of 11th grade were not provided the opportunity to receive intensive instruction and services pursuant to Education Code 37254 (d) (4) and (5) after the completion of grade 12.
