<u>WHO CAN PARTICIPATE</u> - All Tri-Valley area students currently enrolled in their school's performance-based music program may participate.

<u>PIANISTS</u> –Elementary, middle, and high school piano soloists may participate in the festival if they are enrolled in a school music class.

<u>MUSIC SELECTION</u> - One of the main goals of this festival is to foster an appreciation and understanding of standard solo and ensemble literature commonly referred to as "Art Music". Styles such as Jazz or Pop Music are not acceptable.

<u>MEASURES TO BE NUMBERED</u> - All performers must provide a copy of the music/score, with every measure numbered, to the adjudicator.

<u>COMMAND PERFORMANCE SCREENING</u> - The Command Performance (CP) Screening is a process to determine which performers will be selected for the formal Command Performance Concert the evening of the festival. The following outlines the CP screening process:

- 1. If the event adjudicator feels that a performance was outstanding, he/she will recommend the performer(s) for a CP screening.
- 2. If recommended, the performer(s) have one hour to sign up in the Festival Headquarters to perform for the CP screening judge.
  - 3. It is not necessary to have your accompanist with you during the screening.

<u>COMMAND PERFORMANCE</u> - A formal concert, called Command Performance, will be presented the evening of the festival. The concert will feature some of the best performers in the festival from all grade levels and schools. The Command Performance Screening ajudicator selects who will perform in the Command Performance. **The Command Performance will begin at 7:00 pm in the theater at Livermore High School.** 

**NO RATING** - Students may choose to receive a no rating from the adjudicator, but will not be eligible for a "Command Performance."

## TIME LIMIT

- 1. Performance must be limited to FIVE MINUTES.
- 2. Adjudicator comments will be limited to FIVE MINUTES.
- 3. COMMAND PERFORMANCE SCREENING will be limited to FIVE MINUTES.
