- Registration Window: April 19 to May 6
- This is not a "first come, first served" registration. You may change your mind, return to the screen, change your course selections, and submit again anytime the online registration window is open.



Registration - Steps

1. Click on the registration link
2. Enter Username and Password
 - a. username - Student ID Number
 - b. password: birthdate - 5 or 6 digits
 - i. 1 or 2 digits for month, 2 digits for date, 2 digits for year
3. Click on ***Class Registration***
4. Choose Required classes - 5 periods
 - a. English 6, Reading 6, Social Studies 6, PE 6, Science 6
5. Choose Math class - 1 period
 - a. All students will select Math 6. Those recommended for Math 6/7 will be manually placed by the office in June.
 - b. Students interested in Math 7/8 need to sign-up for the testing session in May.
6. Optional - Choose Elective:
 - a. Band, Orchestra, Ukulele, Vocal Music (Choir)
 - b. Students who take an elective as 6th graders will have a zero period class.
7. Click ***Submit***



Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

- Mendenhall is a BYOD school.
