**Overview of School Demographics**

- 2285 Students
- 27% Hispanic/Latino
- 52% White
- <1 % American Indian or Alaska Native
- 8% Asian
- 1% Black or African American
- <1% Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
- 21% Socioeconomically Disadvantaged (SED)
- 5% English Learner (EL)
- 9% Students with Disabilities (SWD)

**2018– 2019 Data Trends (Highlights)**

- California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) English Language Arts (ELA) Proficiency at 67% and Math Proficiency at 50%
- Physical Fitness Test (PFT) 80 percent proficient
- >98% graduation rate; <96 SED and Hispanic
- >4% of students suspended

**2018-2019 Data Analysis and Conclusions**

- Drop in math proficiency indicates a need to focus on math achievement through Alg II
- Increase in PFT proficiency speaks to value of Physical Education (PE) and PE electives
- Very high graduation rate in all student groups
- Increase in suspensions indicates a need to focus on behavioral interventions

**2019-2020 LCAP Site Goals**

- Increase the percentage of students who have the skills and knowledge to graduate from high school, college and/or ready
- Provide an engaging, clean, healthy, and physically and emotionally safe environment to support learning at the highest levels
- Enhance parent and community engagement and communication

**2019-2020 Key Strategies to Meet Goals**

- Provide wide range of universal, targeted, and intensive academic intervention programs
- Support English Language Development (ELD), credit recovery, remediation courses with sections
- Full establishment of a Tier I Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS) system
- Provide range of community outreach opportunities
