

Lawrence Elementary School School Plan for Student Achievement 2019-2020 Executive Summary

Overview of School Demographics

- 357 Students
- 50% White
- 21% Hispanic/Latino
- 15% Asian
- 0% American Indian or Alaska Native
- .3% Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
- 9% 2 or More Races

- 14% Socioeconomically Disadvantaged (SED)

2018 – 2019 Data Trends (Highlights)

- English Language Arts (ELA): % Met or Exceeded Standards on California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP): Overall (64%), 3rd (59%), 4th (60%), 5th (76 %)
- Mathematics: % Met or Exceeded Standards on California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP): Overall (60%), 3rd (57%), 4th (61%), 5th (63 %)
- Writing: % Below Standard on California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Writing Claim: Overall (20%), 3rd (31%), 4th (21%), 5th (5%)
- Fitness Gram: 71% of students achieved the healthy fitness zone in at least 5 out of 6 activities

2018-2019 Data Analysis and Conclusions

- Dashboard data unavailable due to Lawrence Elementary School's official start date of August 2017 and embargoed data for 2018-2019 CAASPP.
- Fifth graders performed well on the English Language Arts CAASPP assessment as measured by 76% of the students meeting or exceeding standard in Overall Achievement for All Students.
- Student participation rate on CAASPP exceeded state expectations with 100% (150 out of 150) enrolled students taking the assessments.
- Lawrence Elementary continues to demonstrate growth on the FitnessGram as measured by the percentage of students achieving the healthy fitness zone in at least 5 out of 6 activities (2019: 71%, 2018: 66%, 2017: 56%).
- Emphasis on attendance, including tardies, will continue to be an area of focus.

2019-2020 LCAP Site Goals

- **Goal 1:** Increase the percentage of students who have the skills and knowledge to graduate from high school, college, and/or career ready
 - ❖ Increase the number of students who meet or exceed standards in ELA from all 3rd-5th grade students from 64% to 67% as measured by the 2020 CAASPP.
 - ❖ Increase the number of students who meet or exceed standards in Math from all 3rd-5th grade students from 60% to 64% as measured by the 2020 CAASPP.
 - ❖ Decrease the number of students who were below standard on the Writing Claim as measured by the 2019 CAASPP from 20% to 15%.

2019-2020 LCAP Site Goals (Continued)

- **Goal 2:** Provide an engaging, clean, healthy, and physically and emotionally safe environment to support learning at the highest levels
 - ❖ Decrease the average number of behavior referrals each month from 46 to 40 as measured by the 2019-2020 School-Wide Information System (SWIS) data.
 - ❖ Increase the overall attendance rate to 97%.
 - ❖ Increase the percentage from 71% to 75% of 5th graders that pass the FitnessGram with a score of 5 or more as measured by the 2020 FitnessGram.
 - ❖ Maintain 5 or fewer suspensions as measured by PowerSchool data.
- Goal 3: Enhance parent and community engagement and communication
 - Maintain strong parent support and involvement.
 - Increase parent participation for Coffee with the Principal Meetings to an average of 24 parents.
 - Maintain an average of 85% of students having one or more parent attend Back to School Night.
