# 2018-2019 Data Trends (Highlights)

- The percentage of students that met or exceeded standards on the CAASPP Mathematics assessment increased by 1%.
- The percentage of students achieving the Healthy Fitness Zone in at least 5/6 assessments is 80%.

- Teachers are differentiating their instruction to ensure that all students are being challenged.
- Physical Fitness teachers are continuing to give pre-tests and practice tests to ensure that students are scoring in the Healthy
  Fitness Zone on the Physical Fitness Assessment.

- To decrease the percentage of students suspended to 1%.
- To improve attendance data to an average of 97%.
- To increase the percentage of students meeting the Healthy Fitness Zone in at least 5/6 activities to 85%.
