    - Paula introduced Measure G which benefits Livermore students. It's the renewal of the existing parcel tax that supports educational programs like science, counselors, teachers, and materials. A 2/3 majority vote is needed to pass this measure on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. If renewed, \$350,000 will be split amoung 18 school sites yearly for 7 years.
    - They are asking that the PTO/PTA organization from each school to fund 5% of their annual budget and to volunteer time for phone banking. The funds will

help to cover operational costs like printing fees, cost of campaign, and political consultants. The phone banking will help bring awareness to the community prior to voting day.
