#### Reports

Principal's Report - Shari Johnston

- Thankful for all the work for the fundraiser.
- Minimum day on 20<sup>th</sup> and no school on 21<sup>st</sup>

Teacher's Report – Bonnie Sanders (TK – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade)

• Staff was thankful for hard work on fun run and gift shop

Teacher's Report – Holly Hamilton (3<sup>rd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> grade)

• Good feedback on fun run – it was worth the extra money spent.

#### Treasurer's Report

- Some spending from teacher accounts since the last meeting.
- Checking account currently at \$55,609.92. Includes all fun run money. Check needs to be cut to Boosterthon.
- Money Market account at \$40,000

• Shade for eating area and bike racks were on the list for fun run spending. Allison will begin checking into that.

# Old Business

Fun Run

- School profit is about \$16,675. Total pledged \$35,000; \$28,000 collected so far.
- Out of 535 students, 73% registered and 337 students got pledges.
- Classes voting at holiday gift shop on prize for raising so much
  - Principal dressed in costume
  - Principal ride around in tricycle
  - o Lip sync battle between Principal and PTO President
- Survey sent to teachers
  - 80% good experience
  - o 50% ok on classroom visits
    - Could skip classroom visits next year
  - 70% ok with teacher responsibility
  - Sending all the emails was too much. Doesn't need to come from teachers and principal.
  - 70% said Boosterthon reps were good.
  - Consider more class and school incentives so kids don't feel left out during prize distribution.
- Teachers have access to videos to use throughout the year. Leah to confirm where videos can be found.
- Need to book for next year. Currently holding Nov 12 21.
  - Three options
    - Full Service Option selected this year. They do everything. We keep up to 65% of funds raised.
    - Fun Run Event Provide all materials but only here for pep rally and fun run. PTO would have to do prizes and encouragement/hype. Tend to raise a little less. We keep 70-75% of funds raised.
    - Fun Run You Everything run by PTO.
  - Alyssa Garshol motioned to book the fun for Nov 12 through 21. Motion seconded by Aimee Holloway. All voted in favor.
    - We will select the option for Boosterthon involvement at a later date.

Science Camp Shirts

- Currently don't have money in a Special Projects budget.
  - Shari Johnston motioned to move \$1,000 from savings account to Special Projects budget. Motion seconded by Holly Hamilton. All voted in favor.
- Ms Clappin & Ms Carey want to make shirts for science camp. Currently on donor's choose but want to get it funded in the next few days. Looking for \$120 from PTO.
  - Shirts should include students that can't attend camp.
  - Emily Park motioned to use \$120 from Special Projects budget to pay for shirts for Science Camp. Motion seconded by Aimee Holloway. All voted in favor.

Family Night Out - Oakland A's
