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### Reports

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#### Principal's Report – Shari Johnston

- Started Stingray Star program this year. Will expand program to explain what a Stingray Star looks like around the school.

#### Teacher's Report – Bonnie Sanders (TK – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade)

- Thank you from teachers for Teacher Appreciation Week.
- Thank you for caterpillars for TK and K.
- Teachers are asking what teacher budgets will be next year so they can plan.
  - Budgets will be approved at last meeting and can be distributed before school is out.

#### Treasurer's Report – Allison Rodacker

- Bank Account Balances
  - Checking - \$60,523.71
  - Savings - \$39,162.45

#### PCIC Report

- The district is changing how teachers will get classroom supplies. District will supply basic supplies. Lists are not going out to families on Arena Day. Letter will go out at the end of the year telling parents that basic supplies will be provided by the district. At the beginning of the year teachers will send a letter requesting money for additional supplies. The letter from the teachers creates a conflict with the request from PTO for the Stingray fund which would provide money to teachers for their classrooms. Need to reconsider how we ask for money next year.
- One school requests volunteers to provide ideas on what they want to see and/or put together at the school. This allows the parents to create their own positions instead of filling old positions.
- Del Valle has a group of Culinary Kids that can provide food for different events.
- East Bay Sports can provide a Family Night Out.
- Library will begin offering wood working on weekends in June.
- District is considering getting rid of the Accelerated Reading Program.
