How to enroll

If your child loves mathematics and likes problem solving, please enroll him/her in our Math Olympiad team by Friday September 21st, 2018. The Lawrence Math Olympiad team is only open to 3rd to 5th grade students. A maximum of 35 students can join the team (first come first served basis). We request a donation of \$10 per year for each student enrolled. (Please see reverse side for enrollment form)

How it works

Students attend Math Olympiad practice/coaching sessions at Lawrence outside of school hours (weekly before school from 7.45 – 8.25am from October through May) for preparation of 5 national contests administered monthly from November to March. There will be five monthly contests*, given from November to March. The dates will be sent to you after we enroll the team. The dates will be final and there will be no retake of the test. Each contest will have five questions that each student completes individually. Each student will work alone on the problems during the contest for 30 minutes. (* Priority will be given to 4th and 5th Grade students)
