

LVJUSD Student One Card Program OPT-OUT FORM 2018-2019

Middle school and high school students are automatically enrolled in the Student One Card Program with the Livermore Public Library. If you would like to opt-out of having your child participate in this program, please complete the bottom portion of this form and turn into your school's front office.

The Student One Card Program allows LVJUSD students to:

- Borrow up to 99 books and select items from any Livermore Public Library location.
- Receive access to online test prep and practice tests for PSAT, SAT, ACT, AP Exams.
- Request books from partner libraries, including academic collections, with Link+.
- Use and download eBooks, online audio books, and magazines 24/7 via the Livermore Public Library website.
- Use online research websites (that normally charge a fee) with pre-vetted articles, books and other media for research assignments and projects.
- Access to Tutor.com for online tutoring.
- Explore scholarship opportunities online.
- Practice a language in a self-led, online course and speak with a native speaker of a foreign language.
- Access quiet areas for study and free Wifi at the library.
- Participate in regularly scheduled events and classes.

<u>Fines/Fees:</u> As of July 1, 2019, the Livermore Public Library moved from an overdue fines model to a materials recovery model. This means that patrons will no longer owe an overdue fine if they need to return an item a few days late. In order to encourage the return of materials so others may enjoy them, patrons with items overdue by one week or more will not be able to check out additional items until the late items have been returned. Patrons will still be billed for the cost of an item once it is four weeks overdue.
