- -Print and attach the entry form to the back of the photo with a paper clip. DO NOT STAPLE.
- -Entries must be received by Friday, January 10, 2020. Submissions can be turned in to a student's art teacher, science teacher, or to Regina Brinker at the LVJUSD District Office, 685 E. Jack London Blvd., Livemore, CA 94551

Judging:

Photos will be judged by members of the Livermore Arts Commission according to artistic merit, creativity, and interpretation of the theme. Both the photo and written description are reviewed. Top photos will be selected from grades K-5, 6-8, and 9-12.
