


How did people respond?

Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?





Favorable: 35%


Q.4: At your school, how often are you encouraged to think more deeply about race-related topics?




Q.5: How comfortable are you sharing your thoughts about race-related topics with other students at your school?





Q.6: How often do students at your school have important conversations about race, even when they might be uncomfortable?


















Teacher-Student Relationships




Q.2: If you walked into class upset, how many of your


