Paws to Read is a wonderful initiative that pairs students with trained therapy dogs to provide a supportive and non-judgmental environment for reading practice. Research has shown that reading to dogs can help improve children's confidence, fluency and enjoyment of reading.

- Paws to Read sessions will take place on Tuesday mornings in our library.
- Each session will last approximately 15 minutes.
- Students will be paired with a trained therapy dog and a handler in a designated reading area.
- Reading sessions will be conducted in a quiet and supportive environment.
