

2023 SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP

To support and further the education of students in our community, the Board of Directors of the Hindu Community and Cultural Center have established three perpetual scholarships of **\$500.00** each to be awarded to a worthy high school graduating senior at each of the comprehensive high schools (Granada High and Livermore High) and one among seniors graduating from alternative schools in the Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior of Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District High Schools
- Submit a completed scholarship application by the posted deadline
- Have acceptance as a full time student at an accredited college

SELECTION PROCESS / CRITERIA (100 pts. possible):

Finalists will be selected based on:

- Overall GPA (20 pts.)
- Community Service (20 pts.)
- Leadership (20 pts.)
- Positive interaction and outreach with students of diverse backgrounds (10 pts.)
- Student essay (30 pts.) on the following topic:
“Describe how you have and will contribute to the achievement of cultural, ethnic, religious, and/or gender harmony, mutual respect, and care among young adults in a diversified society.” Respond in 350 words or less

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applications will be emailed to senior students and will be available on the Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District website, www.livermoreschools.org, and the high school websites.

TIMELINE / DEADLINE:
