1:30	Class is dismissed

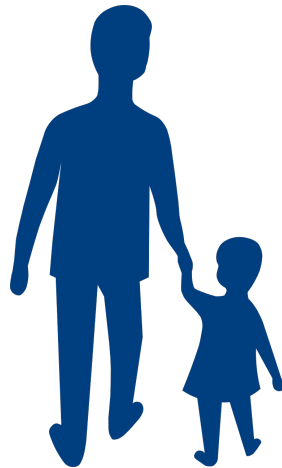


# Arrival and Dismissal

**Arrival:** The classroom door opens at 8:25 to allow your child to ease into their daily routine instead of feeling rushed. School will start promptly at 8:30.

**Dismissal:** School ends at 1:30 each day. Children will be dismissed one at a time in order to make sure each child connects with their parent or daycare provider.

# Helpful Hints for a Healthy Year



Pack **one** healthy snack each day, as we have limited time to eat. (Please NO candy or cookies)

Pack lunches with good nutrition in mind. (Don't forget to label it!) Hot lunch is also available. I recommend waiting a few weeks before ordering hot lunch, until your child is familiar with our lunchtime routine. Menus are online.

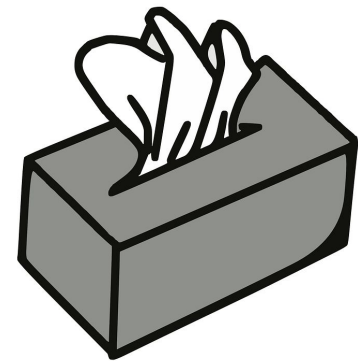
Send a full water bottle each day (Don't forget to label it!)

# Personal Belongings

Your child's backpack needs to be a standard size backpack. Many popular character backpacks are too small to accommodate items going to and from class.

Label your child's backpack and always keep a change of clothes, including underwear, in a ziplock bag at the the bottom.

Please label all coats, sweatshirts, and other outerwear. Children often get separated from these items and this will help with getting them back to you.

Label lunch boxes and water bottles with your child's name and room number #3.



# Parking

- The first week will be challenging in terms of traffic and congestion. Please be prepared to park away from the school and walk your child to the classroom.
- Please do not park or stop in the handicapped designated spots in front of class.
- Please do not park in the 'Permit Only' designated spots in front of class during any part of the day.



# Volunteering at Sunset

- A classroom volunteer must complete a Volunteer Application online, submit for clearance/background check to the Livermore Police Department (LPD)
- A copy of your Negative TB screening (freedom from TB) must be on file with the school office, (TB copy is good for 4 years)
- Volunteer Application must be renewed every school year
- Volunteer Application will need LPD clearance and will take approximately 2 weeks
- All parents/guardians wanting to attend field trips, class parties, volunteer at school events, help in the classroom, must be volunteer cleared. Classroom volunteers need to have a teacher approved volunteer job in the classroom
- Please complete your application and TB forms in August so you'll be ready to volunteer in September
