## **PROBATION APPLICATION**

A student who fails to achieve a 2.0 GPA may seek a period of probationary eligibility <u>one time</u> <u>during high school and one time during middle school</u>. The probationary period shall be for one grading period at both the high school and middle school levels.

To apply for this probation, the student's parent/guardian must submit a written request on this form or as an attached letter and submit it to the athletic director. This request must be submitted immediately following notification of ineligibility. Failure to achieve a 2.0 GPA during the probationary period will render the student ineligible during all subsequent grading periods until a 2.0 GPA is achieved.
