

PROBATION APPLICATION

A student who fails to achieve a 2.0 GPA may seek a period of probationary eligibility one time during high school and one time during middle school. The probationary period shall be for one grading period at both the high school and middle school levels.

To apply for this probation, the student's parent/guardian must submit a written request on this form or as an attached letter and submit it to the athletic director. This request must be submitted immediately following notification of ineligibility. Failure to achieve a 2.0 GPA during the probationary period will render the student ineligible during all subsequent grading periods until a 2.0 GPA is achieved.
